Praise the Lord to all prayer partners and thank you for your continuous prayer and support to us. We are excited and happy to provide you with our mission update and of how God is leading our path in the mission field to accomplish His will in our life.



Last month we celebrated our Church's 2nd Anniversary. We are so thankful to the Lord for giving us another year to serve Him faithfully. These two years were not easy. We went through many struggles and discouragements, but Praise God that through his mercy and grace, we were able to overcome every difficult situation.

Like last year, we used this opportunity to share the gospel in the community. More than 150 people attended our anniversary service. Pastor Richard Jacob and his wife Mrs. Leah Jacob, from Nashville Baptist Church, came from Tennessee to attend our 2nd Church anniversary service. Pastor Richard Jacob presented a clear gospel message, which worked in the hearts of people. Many came forward after the invitation. We are following up and looking for genuine converts to disciple them.

We estimated that around 80 people would come for the Anniversary service and accordingly we ordered the food, but the number was almost double. Yet the Lord graciously provided the food for every guest, and no one went hungry. Many new contacts were made, and a new village ministry door was opened.

All the believers who have gotten saved through our ministry here in Amravati, as well as those working in different cities and villages like Pune, Mumbai, and many small villages, came for the anniversary service. They all were excited, and it was a joy to see and meet them all personally. They all join our church services on Zoom due to their location constraints.

The next day, Monday, we also had a Sunday School kids gathering where Mrs. Leah gave a gospel lesson to around 25 kids. The kids had a very blessed time with singing, teaching, and sharing gifts. Please keep these kids in your prayers as they all are from Hindu backgrounds. Please pray that they will get saved and grow in the Lord. We see so much potential in the Children's ministry to grow first generation Christians.

In October, we got the opportunity to attend the Mission conference and to meet Brother David Cloud at Sangati Baptist Church in Nepal. My family and I were blessed and renewed by the fellowship and preaching done by Pastor Steve Boots and Brother David Cloud at the mission conference. I also got the opportunity to share my testimony, as well.

At Amravati Baptist Church, we have two new visitors, Meera and Gita, coming to church. They are Hindu and worship the snake idols. But since they have visited our church, they are so excited about the teaching and preaching and told me that no one ever told them the truth about Jesus. They have been coming for the last three weeks, and I see their hunger for God's Word and their desire to know the truth. Please pray that God will open their understanding for salvation. We will be having a Christmas celebration at our home, and we are excited to invite them all to our house.

Our Bus Stop ministry (where I am able to distribute NT Bibles to the bus travelers) and Hospital ministry (where I am able to distribute gospel tracts and to the hospital patients) are going well. The Lord has given me a plenty of

opportunities to witness and provide the complete gospel plan to many people through these ministries. With the people who show much interest, I usually take their contact details and add them to our church's WhatsApp group so they get to listen to more preaching and can stay connected.

By the Lord's grace we were able to purchase a new vehicle. As Yohan is growing, it was getting difficult for all three of us to travel on a moped. Also, due to my previous IT Job, I had a pre-approved car loan. It would have been difficult for us to purchase a vehicle otherwise, as they would ask for a lot of documentation, which I couldn't provide since I had quit my job. It was all of God's providence for us in getting the car.
